5. Agenda: There was correspondence sent to Ms. Campbell on Aug. 25, 1998 to appear before Council on Sept. 4, 1998. Ms Campbell did not appear (see minutes -- Special Meeting, Sept 4, 1998) She was again notified on Sept. 23, 1998, by Process Server, Gary Valuet , as suggested by Attorneys, that the date of the Show Cause Hearing would be held on Oct. 16, 1998, at 11:00 P.M.. A Public Hearing Notice was posted on Oct. 8, 1998. Attempts were made to contact her by telephone, on the day of the Hearing, before 11:00 A.M., but they were not successful.

Zoning Administrator, Ed Spayd, showed Council videos of Ms. Campbell's residence, taken this morning, Oct. 16, 1998. Some cleanup had been done, but trash was still visible, rabbits were still there, one dog was seen, and there was a No Trespassing sign and a For Sale By Owner sign visible.

Complainant, Carl Walter's, Lot #311, Weidman, Mi. 48893, a next-door neighbor, told Council that on Friday, Oct. 4, 1998, he saw her open her garage door and let out at least 15 cats, she poured a 5 pound bag of food on the driveway for them.. She watered other animals, and then turned large dog loose to run, dog was still loose the next day, while she was not at home.. She then picked up her cats and put them in the garage and shut door. He also noted an odor from premises.(rabbit hutches and garage) He also noted that many bags of trash were disposed of after the 1 st Show-Cause Hearing, but that he has not seen any trash disposed of lately.

A motion by Jack Adkins to direct the Zoning Administrator, Ed Spayd to proceed with a Formal Complaint in Circuit Court was seconded by Tom Debour.. Approved by all - Motion passed.

Ms. Campbell did not appear, and will be notified as to the Councils finding.
