- Whereas;** the Village of Lake Isabella is a Home Rule Village; and,
Whereas; the incorporated boundaries of the Village include Duquesa Road to the Village limits; and,
Whereas; there is a one-half mile gap between the Village limits and Drew Road along the path that Duquesa Road naturally follows; and,
Whereas; this section of road is used by numerous residents of the Village; and,
Whereas; this section of road is used by various public entities including first responders; and,
Whereas; this section of road satisfies the requirements of MCL 220.20 "Highway by User" to be declared a public roadway; and,

Now therefore be it resolved;

The Village of Lake Isabella is prevented from declaring this section of road as a "Highway by User" as it is outside of the Village limits; and,

The sole jurisdiction to declare this section of road a public roadway via "Highway by User" is the Isabella County Road Commission; and,

The Village of Lake Isabella has provided documentation to the Isabella County Road Commission on this issue; and,

The Village hereby requests that the Isabella County Road Commission declare this section of Duquesa Road a public roadway via "Highway by User;" and,

The Village agrees to work with the Isabella County Road Commission in seeking grant monies for the needed improvements of Duquesa Road.
