

**Village of Lake Isabella
Isabella County, Michigan**

**Invitation to Bidders
2018 Queens Way/El Camino Mill & Fill**

PROJECT SCOPE:

This project shall consist of a partial depth mill of 1.5 inches (1 ½”) from the existing HMA surface, and an overlay paving of 2 inches (2”) of Hot Mix Asphalt meeting the Local Agency Program specifications of the Michigan Department of Transportation as revised on 11/01/2017. Total linear feet of roadway to mill & fill is 3,275.

These areas of Queens Way and El Camino Grande have existing HMA pavement of 24 +/- feet wide. This pavement was originally done in 2003 at a depth of 3 ½ inches (3.5”), The intersection of Queens Way and El Camino Grande has an existing cement curb which is to be maintained by tapering the HMA thickness at those locations to match the exiting grade of curb height. Likewise, this section of Queens Way also features an existing HMA curb and spillway, these structures are to be preserved and maintained.

Proposals are due back to the Village by 4 PM on Friday, August 3, 2018. It is anticipated that a project award will be made at the Village Council meeting on Tuesday, August 21, 2018.

SPECIFICATIONS:

All materials, equipment, and construction methods used on the project shall be in accordance with MDOT Standard Specification for Construction, and the included HMA requirements.

BID REQUIREMENTS:

1. All bids must be submitted on the provided Bid Submission Form. Bids shall be legibly prepared in ink or typewriter.
2. Bids shall be received by the Village of Lake Isabella until **4 PM, on Friday, August 3, 2018**. Bids will not be accepted after this deadline.
3. It should be understood by any bidder that the Village of Lake Isabella is a tax exempt local unit of government.
4. The bidder shall save and hold harmless the Village and its employees from and against all claims, damages, losses, or expenses arising out or resulting from the performance of the work; provided that any such claim, damage, loss, or expense is caused in whole or in part by any negligent or willful act of omission of the contractor, subcontractor, employee, or anyone under their direction.

COMPETENCY OF BIDDERS:

Bidders must be currently qualified with the Michigan Department of Transportation for work listed on the invitation to bid. A current copy of the pre-certification rating must be submitted with the bid.

PROGRESS SCHEDULE:

Begin all work after receiving notice of award from the Village. All items of work shall be completed by Friday, October 26, 2018.

No work shall be performed during the 2018 Labor Day holiday weekend, specifically the dates of September 1st through September 3rd.

Restoration and additional shoulder gravel are not part of this invitation to bid.

MAINTAINING TRAFFIC:

Contractor shall furnish, erect, and maintain barricades, drums, cones, signals, and cones adjacent to the work and provide traffic regulators as operations may require. All signs and barricades shall be accordance with the most recent edition of Michigan Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MMUTCD). All traffic control devices needed shall be paid for under the item “*Temporary Traffic Devices & Traffic Control*”.

Temporary pavement markings shall be Type R tape and shall be placed in a double line of 4 inch (4”) wide by min. 4 feet (4’) long strips spaced approximately 50 feet apart to identify no-passing zones. Final pavement markings shall be applied within 2 weeks of paving.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS:

Insurance Certificate declaring the Village of Lake Isabella as additional insured. Not certificate holder, must be issued and provided to the Village within 15 days of a notice of award.

The HMA Surface Mixture LVSP shall have a yield minimum of 220 pounds per square yard. The Performance Grade asphalt binder range shall be PG 58-28.
