

Request for Proposal Village Welcome Sign Lighting Project

This is a Request for Proposals (RFP) issued by the Village of Lake Isabella, seeking proposals from qualified Electrical Contractors to install lighting for the Village's Welcome Sign. The sign is located at the Village's DPW Facility at 201 S. Coldwater Road. Any costs incurred in preparing or submitting a proposal shall be the responsibility of the bidder.

Scope of Work

The Village of Lake Isabella is seeking a Lump Sum proposal, including applicable permits, to install approximately 225' total of underground wire from an existing electrical service point on the property to the Village's Welcome Sign. Existing service box is roughly 175' from the Welcome Sign. It is estimated that as much as 50' of wire may be needed from that point to the sign. At the Welcome Sign, the proposal is to include the installation of exterior lighting to illuminate both the south and north façade of the sign. Exterior lighting for each side of the sign shall be a single ground mounted LED centered below the sign. Light is to be equipped with a dusk-till-dawn sensor.

Timeframe

Interested parties are requested to return a signed proposal on company letterhead to the Village Hall at the address below by the close of business (4:30 PM Local Time) on Wednesday, May 10, 2017.

Work is to be completed by June 30, 2017.
