Dear Sean:

I would like to briefly respond to your memo (see attached) outlining our meeting this past February. Specifically the area I would like to touch base with you on is in regards to the criteria and conditions that are required by the DEQ in order to amend the building and use restriction to on-site well and septic systems in Lake Isabella South. We have been working on finding locations to conduct soil tests and to obtain water samples per our meeting this February. As we continue in this process we would like to know specifically the number of locations we should be attempting to find. In addition to this, we would like to know specifically if there are any other conditions that we need to be working on other than those in the attached letter.

We are also working on obtaining the same information in the Lake Isabella Airpark plat. Please be advised that we are currently working on having the consent judgment pertaining to our sewer escrow fund amended so that we are able to use these funds on a pro-rated basis in each of the five plats with buildability issues. If we are successful in having the judgment amended, the Village would like to tackle the buildability issue in an aggressive manner in 2008 with a goal of having the matter of buildability resolved in all five plats no later than the end of 2009. If we are unable to amend the consent judgment our primary focus will remain in the Lake Isabella Airpark and Canterbury Estates plats as we feel those areas will be the least cumbersome to resolve.
