Tim,

In your letter of November 28, 2007, you asked for a specific number of locations that will be needed to assess the soil suitability of the Airpark and Lake Isabella South Plats for on-site wastewater locations. The number of soil excavation locations is directly related to characterization and uniformity of the soil profiles. Since, these factors can not be determined until the site is evaluated, the best course of action is to continue to have Rowe Engineering prepare a plan, as discussed in our meeting and reiterated in my letter of March 19, 2007, detailing all accessible locations available for conducting soil evaluations. During the site visit, a decision will be made on how many soil evaluations are needed to confirm suitability.

As far as any other specific conditions in addition to those stated in the March 19, 2007 letter, evaluation of water supplies and soil suitability for wastewater systems on a project wide scale continue to be the only relevant issues to the situation.

Also, please CC. Mr. Jones of the CMDHD on any further correspondence, as our departments will be continuing to work jointly to assess site suitability of the plats in question.
